This morning we held a whole school assembly for our KS1 and KS2 children, where we looked at who the Queen was and the impact she had on the British Empire during her long reign, we recalled the work we completed during the Jubilee celebrations and discussed who the new King would be.

We were lucky enough yesterday to also receive a letter from one of the Queen's lady's in waiting thanking the pupils for all the letters and work which was sent to her during the Jubilee celebrations. This letter was read and shared with the children in assembly this morning too. We will tweet this letter on our page later on today.

We have now entered a period of national mourning that will continue until the end of the State Funeral. As soon as we receive guidance of these funeral arrangements, we will inform you as necessary.

Next week in school, all children will take part in a number of activities. We will also have a school condolence book where all children will write a message, draw a picture to say thank you to the Queen.
