Year 3 Reading Core Skills

I can...

- Comment on the way the characters relate to one another
- Know which words are essential in a sentence to retain meaning
- Draw inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions
- Recognise how commas are used to give more meaning
- Recognise inverted commas
- Recognise:
 - ✓ Plurals
 - ✓ Pronouns and how they are used
 - ✓ Collective nouns
 - ✓ Adverbs
- Explain the difference that the precise choice of adjectives and verbs make



Year 3 Writing Core Skills

I can...

- Use conjunctions (when, so, before, after, while, because)
- Use adverbs (e.g. then, next, soon)
- Use prepositions (e.g. before, after, during, in, because of)
- Experiment with adjectives to create impact
- Correctly use verbs in 1st, 2nd and 3rd person
- Use perfect form of verbs to make relationships of time and cause
- Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech
- Group ideas into basic paragraphs
- Write under heading and sub-headings
- Write with increasingly legibility, consistency and fluency



Year 3 Maths Core Skills

I can...

- compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write all numbers to 1000 in digits and words
- Find 10 or 100 more/less than a given number
- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100
- Recall and use multiplication & division facts for 3, 4, & 8 tables
- Recognise place value of any 3 digit number
- Add and subtract:
 - ✓ 3 digit numbers and ones
 - ✓ 3 digit numbers and tens
 - ✓ 3 digit numbers and hundreds
- Add and subtract:
 - ✓ Numbers with up to 3 digits using the column method
- Estimate and use inverse to check
- Multiply 2 digit by 1 digit
- Count up/down in tenths
- Compare and order fractions with the same denominator
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator with whole
- Tell the time using 12 and 24 hour clocks; and using Roman numerals
- Tell time to the nearest minute
- Know number of days in each month and number of seconds in a minute



Reading

- ▶ Children will have a range of reading books in the classroom
- ▶ Children will be building on the phonics they have learned and beginning to build their comprehension skills through retrieval, inference, vocabulary exploration and a variety of other methods as they complete the RWI scheme.

Home Learning

- ▶ Children have access to a variety of programs they can access at home to support there learning.
