Just a reminder that PE is every Monday & Friday.

Please remember to remove earrings and send children with their water bottles wearing their outdoor PE kit, PE will be taught outside –weather permitting – so children will require suitable warm tops and pumps or trainers that have non-slip soles.

We will be out in a range of weather conditions.

Please can children leave their PE kits in school – they will be returned at the end of the half term, or more frequently if they need washing.



Weekly homework will be set and their CGP Maths Homework Books will be handed out on a **Friday**, completing pages set by the class teacher and this will be expected to be returned on the

following Wednesday to be marked and organised ready for the next homework to be set.

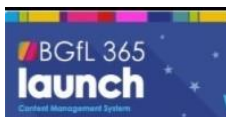
Some children will also be expected to access their Reading Plus accounts from home on a weekly basis where allocated. The logins are in their Reading Records. If they do not use them please read at least 3x per week

Reading Plus will now also run alongside home reading books and journals for children, so please ensure children **bring their reading books to school daily** and these will be expected to be read and changed weekly, as well as making sure they are also logging in to complete the activities as often as possible on reading plus (3 times a week from home where possible).



Books will be changed on Fridays however, we will be checking that they are in school daily. If your child finishes a book sooner the book can be changed at any point during the week. We send books home daily, please allow your child to read as much as possible, this can be heard by you or interdepend reading by the child..

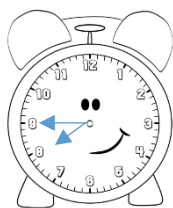
