This term both schools have participated together with activities and events.

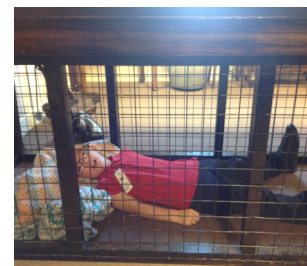
EDUCATIONAL VISITS
