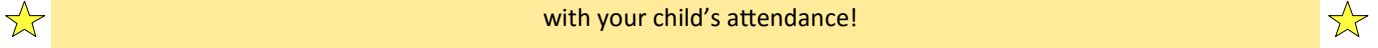


HANBURYS FARM SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

EASTER ASSEMBLIES

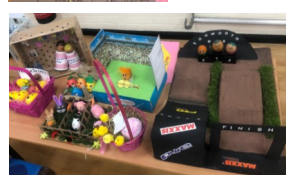
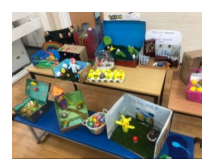
