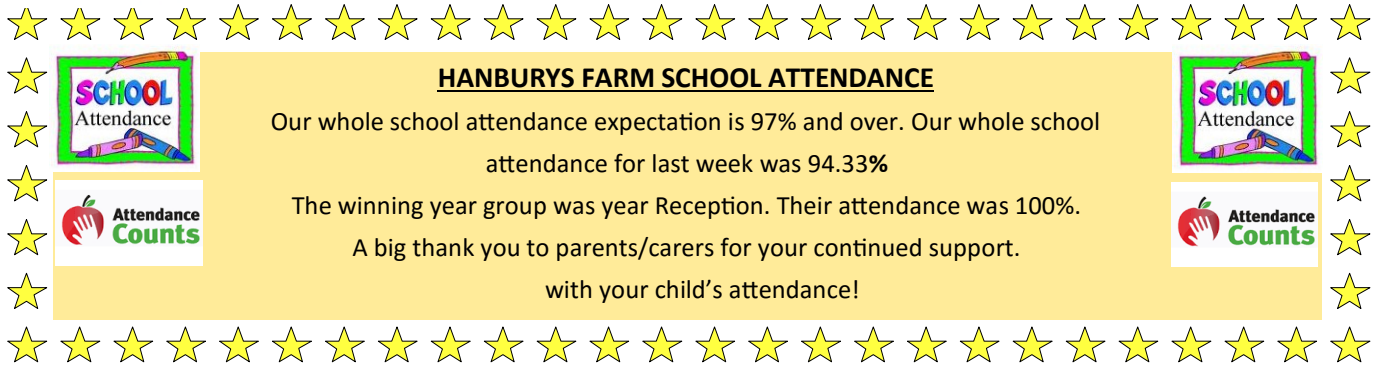

### INFORMATION FOR CURRENT YEAR 2 UNIVERSAL FREE SCHOOL MEALS

**ALL** pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are currently entitled to Universal Free School Meals, meaning they get a free school meal everyday if they choose too. However, once your child moves into year 3, this provision ends. If your child is currently in year 2 and you think you may be eligible to claim free school meals for your child (ren), please apply this term otherwise you will have to start paying for your child's school meals from September, which are currently £2.58 per day or £11.50 a week per child. You can apply online at [www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals/staffordshire](http://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals/staffordshire) or you can come to the school office where Mrs Wright or Miss Wilson can help you make an application. **Don't leave it too late!**
