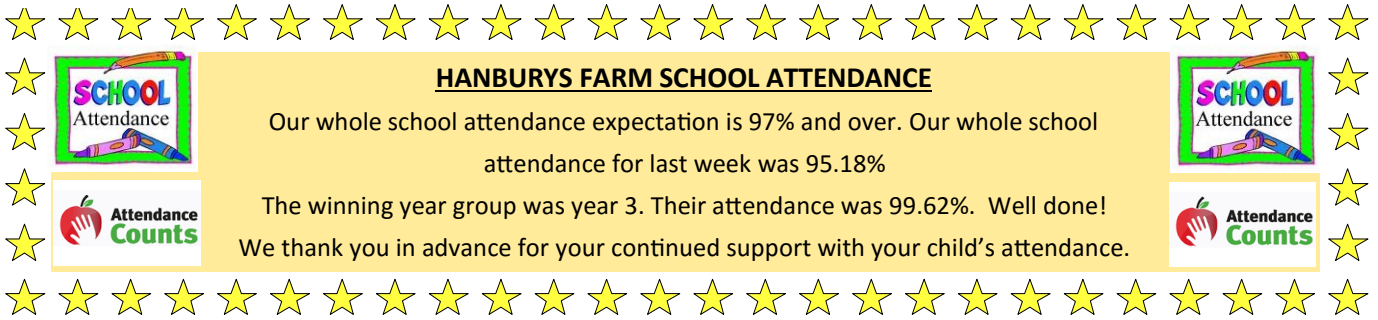

### CORONAVIRUS - PUBLIC HEALTH ADVICE AND GUIDANCE

As you may now be aware, there has been a confirmed case of Coronavirus at St Gabriel's Primary School, Tamworth.

In keeping with the Department for Education current guidance for educational settings, it states that we should be 'attending educational establishments or work as usual'.

We have also been in contact with the public health this morning for advice and guidance regarding this. At this stage they have advised us to inform parents/carers of the importance of hygiene. Personal hygiene is the most important way to tackle COVID-19, especially washing hands more; and the catch it, bin it, kill it strategy for those with coughs and sneezes. Wash your hands more often for 20 seconds with soap and hot water. In addition to handwashing before eating and after sneezing, both children and parents should wash hands after using toilets and after travelling on public transport.
